Rabbi/Cantor Didi Thomas is the founding Rabbi for Temple Emet of Torrance, which is a highly participatory community dedicated to creating a sense of family amongst congregants, enhanced worship and learning experiences, as well as a greater connection with the Divine.

Rabbi Thomas was Ordained in New York receiving S'micha as "HaRav V' Chazzan" from the Rabbinical Seminary International, privately studying under Rabbi Joseph Gelberman z"l. She is schooled in Kabbalah, received Chaplaincy training from Zale Lipshy Hospital in Dallas, Texas, and is one of a handful of clergy serving as both Rabbi and Cantor.

Having worked as a professional actress and singer, she is a member of the Screen Actor's Guild, the American Federation of Radio and Television Artists, and Actor's Equity Association. Prior to her work in Jewish Synagogue life, Rabbi Didi worked in all mediums of film, television and theater, with training from the Beverly Hills Playhouse and USC.



Rev Kathy McCall has been a life-long spiritual seeker. She has served five different churches as a Unity Minister in Tempe, Arizona, Palo Alto, Santa Cruz, Santa Rosa, and currently Unity of South Bay in Torrance, CA.
